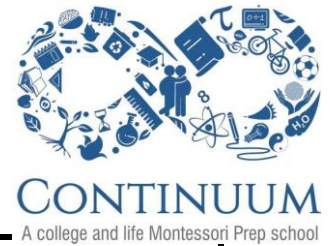


2026-2027 Tuition Schedule

* The 10 monthly payments begin in February of the prior school year with the 1st Tuition Payment/Re-Enrollment Fee. The remaining 9 monthly tuition payments are made in July, 2026 through January, 2027, and March and April, 2027. Continuum accepts all private school Step-Up for Student Scholarship Awards including FTC/FES-EO, FES-UA, and HOPE. Anticipated Step Up for Students scholarship amounts are not finalized or confirmed until late July or early August and therefore cannot be applied until confirmed. Accordingly, the first two tuition payments must be paid in full without consideration of anticipated scholarship funds; payments beginning in August through April will reflect the confirmed scholarship differential once finalized through Step Up and the student has been placed by the family on the Continuum roster through EMA.

A Materials/Activities Fee for supplies and unique learning experiences that are integral to the Montessori curriculum is required for each student depending on their program level and is as follows: Lower Elementary \$600; Upper Elementary \$625; Middle School \$750, and High School \$825. This fee is not included in the tuition, is due July 1, 2025, and is non-refundable.

The Upper Elementary, Middle School, and High School students participate in off-campus Field Outings and Field Studies of two days to two-weeks duration each school year. The cost for these experiences varies according to expenses for transportation and lodging and has been projected to be approximately \$500 per school year for the Upper Elementary and \$1,200 - \$2,500 for the Middle School. Field studies for the High School held outside of the United States may cost up to \$3,000. Upper Elementary, Middle School, and High School students may also incur additional charges for literature books and textbooks. A student's work and financial account must be current in order for the student to participate in travel.

Timely Pickup is required. Late Fees of \$1.00 per minute for the first 15 minutes, and a flat fee of \$30 per each additional 1 – 15 minutes block thereafter, will be charged.
